FINANCIAL SERVICES The Retired Boxers Foundation will raise funds to establish a charitable trust fund to help boxers in critical need of financial assistance as well as counseling to secure a financial base in their retirement. Personal financial management services, including tax assistance will also be offered to insure their long-term financial stability and solvency.

REHABILITATION SERVICES The RBF will provide specialized medical services and facilities for the rehabilitation of retired professional boxers suffering from pugilistic dementia. Other health related services will include physical therapy, personal and peer counseling, substance abuse treatment and support groups.

HOUSING SERVICES The objective of residential care services is to break the cycle of homelessness and assist retired boxers to achieve an independent lifestyle. Housing will be available to those who are homeless and without the means to secure even the basic human needs, including food, shelter and safety.


YOUTH SERVICES Many professional boxers were once youngsters whose lives were touched by a caring adult who mentored them. RBF will organize activities to assist disadvantaged youth, including summer boxing camps, academic enrichment programs, youth boxing programs, and youth mentoring.

SENIOR CITIZEN SERVICES The RBF will provide supportive services to senior citizens including assistance with simple daily tasks such as transportation, assistance with complicated medical bills and personal business. More importantly, the RBF will make every effort to bring them back into the boxing profession by encouraging their participation in mentoring projects with youth. Senior retired boxers can and should encourage and mentor the youth of our communities, providing the guidance they sometimes lack.
